- 3. Grace What God has done and will do for man because Christ died for them Grace is undeserved unmerited favor. Eph 2:8,9
- 4. Imputation The act of God whereby He credits perfect righteousness to the believer in Christ. Rom 4:5
- 5. In Christ The believer is in eternal union with Christ or is "In Christ".

 II Cor. 5:17 Rom 8:1
- 6. Justified Vindicated, the judicial act of God whereby He declares righteous the one who has believed "In Christ". Rom 3:24
- 7. Propitiation Mercy seat, satisfaction, Christ blood satisfied.

 I Jn 2:2, the righteousness and justice of God.
- 8. Reconciliation To reconcile those at variance. Through Christ death for those who are ungodly, without strength, sinners, enemies, man can now through faith be changed and adjusted to God. Rom. 5:10,11
- 9. Redemption Set free by paying the price, to purchase out of the slave market of sin never to be put up for sale again. Eph: 1:7
- 10. Regeneration The act of the believer receiving a new nature; to be "Born Again"

- 11. Remission Put off or to put away sin. Isa. 43:25

- 13. Sanctification "Saint, santify" and "Holy" are from the same greek root word which means to be set apart unto God. I Cor. 1:2
- 14. Spirituality The state of the believer controlled by the Holy Sprit. Eph 5:18 IJn 1:7
- 15. Tribulation Period of 7 literal years on this earth, beginning with the Rapture and ending with the Sec nd Advent. Dan. 9:24 Matt. 24
- 16. Vicarious Substitutionary; Christ died on behalf of the whole world.

- 17. Worldliness A mental attitude that excludes the person of Jesus Christ.
