OLD SIN NATURE

- 1. Believers possess an Old Sin Nature after salvation I John 1:8; Col. 3:5-13; Rom. 7:14.15
- 2. The Old Sin Nature is desperately wicked Jere. 17:9; Isa. 64:6
- 3. Believers under Old Sin Nature's control (ICor. 3:1-3) are called carnal or fleshly Rom. 7:14
- 4. The Old Sin Nature frustrates bona fide production in Christian Way of Life Rom. 7:15; Gal. 5:17
- 5. We get an Old Sin Nature perpetrated through procreation Rom. 5:12; Psa. 51:5; I Tim. 2:13-15
- 6. Old Sin Nature produces sinfulness and human good Isa. 64:6; Rom. 8:8
- 7. Old Sin Nature isn't found in resurrection body of believers Phil. 3:20, 21

POSITIONAL TRUTH

- 1. It isn't emotions or an experience.
- 2. It isn't progressive; can't be improved on.
- 3. It isn't related to human merit; no works involved.
- 4. It is eternal in nature.
- 5. It is known only by divine revelation found in God's Word.
- 6. It is obtained en toto (completely) at the moment of salvation.
